Congratulations!

You have been accepted to Miami City Ballet School's 2026 Summer Intensive.

We are excited to invite you for the opportunity to train with our world-renowned faculty among fellow students for a summer of superb classes and memorable experiences. During this summer program, students will experience intensive and exceptional training to support growth and confidence within their dancing.

Students can expect up to 20 hours of dance instruction per week. Each week's schedule may vary. Depending on the level, these classes include: Technique, Pointe, Repertory, Pas de Deux, Men's and Women's Variations, Contemporary, Musical Theater, Stretch & Strength, and Pilates.

Classes are held six days per week (Monday through Saturday).

On the first day of the program, all students will participate in a level placement class and program orientation.

All initial registration materials must be completed and submitted online via the MCB School Portal. Please use the login credentials found in your acceptance email to log in to your account.

In order to secure your spot, the following must be paid: Registration & Activity Fees, a 50% Tuition deposit, and (if applicable) a 30% housing deposit with all registration forms submitted to MCBS.

The program is on a first-come-first-serve basis. Registration deadline is 14 business days after the acceptance email was received. Once the program reaches full capacity, you will be placed on a Wait List. Be sure to complete registration as soon as possible to ensure your place in the program.

Please note that students must commit to the entirety of the program. Summer Intensive, students who demonstrate exceptional talent, potential, and commitment are invited to join MCB School's year-round training program.

Invitations will be sent at the end of the program.

GROUP PLACEMENT

Placement Class will be held on the first day of the program on MONDAY, June 22nd. Students' assigned groups for the MCB Summer Intensive will be posted in the School Portal on the second day of the Summer Intensive, Tuesday, June 23rd. Details on placement day and the first day of the program will be emailed 1 week before the start of the program. Placement is exclusively decided by Artistic Staff and is non-negotiable. Students will continue to be evaluated throughout the first week of the intensive.

SCHEDULE

Students will follow the Orientation and Placement Day Schedule for MONDAY, June 22nd. Placement & Orientation Day Schedule will be sent via email 1 week prior to the start of the program.

Final Summer Schedule with the assigned class groups will be available in the student's MCB School portal on TUESDAY, June 23rd. During this first week, if a student's group placement is changed at the discretion of MCB Artistic Staff, student will be notified by email.

MONDAY – FRIDAY *Subject to change

- Students will attend classes with either a morning schedule or late afternoon schedule
- All students will have at least 3.5 - 4 hrs of instruction M - F plus 1 hour lunch break.
- Schedules may vary according to student's assigned level
- Students will be responsible for packing their own lunch (unless at Collins Pointe)

SATURDAY *Subject to Change

- Students will attend classes on Saturday with either a morning schedule or early afternoon schedule.
- All students will have at least 2.5 hrs of instruction on Saturday with no lunch break.

CLASS ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Please arrive at least a half an hour early to check in on the first day to receive your placement class number. The placement class schedule will be sent 1 week before the start of the program, with your first day's schedule. All students are responsible for getting to and from the studios. All Students will be expected to leave the building as soon as class ends. The last day of Classes will be on Friday, July 24th.

ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

Activities: Throughout the programs, we aim to build community and harbor a safe, inclusive, and accepting environment for all of our students. Students will have the opportunity to participate in activities specially curated to support student life, creativity, self-awareness, and engage students to help build new and lasting friendships. Activities are offered to all students throughout our programs at no additional costs. There are multiple activities scheduled throughout the week after classes and we encourage all students to participate.

Excursions: Students enrolled in the Summer Intensive will be able to sign up and purchase excursions planned in and around Miami to foster a fantastic summer dance experience. There will be an excursion planned for every Sunday during the 5-week program. The fees paid at registration do not cover weekend excursions. Weekend Excursions will be announced by May 2026. All registered students will have the option to sign up and pay for excursions in advance through Add-Ons in the MCBS Portal. We encourage all students to join and experience Miami outside of the studio. Updates and Information will be shared via email.

PARENT OBSERVATION CLASS

Parents/Guardians will be invited to enter the building to observe a specific class on the final day of the program, Friday, July 24th. More information regarding the time will be released closer to the date.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Miami City Ballet School is certified by the Student and Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) to enroll non-immigrant students on M-1 visas. International students who are invited to enroll in the 5-week summer program will be required to obtain an M-1 student visa in order to attend the Program.

Miami City Ballet School's PDSO and/or DSO will provide the student with the form and guidance on how to apply for the visa. A staff member will contact students who indicate a country of citizenship outside of the United States in their registration form. All costs related to the M-1 visa application are paid by the student and can vary. International students must have medical insurance or medical travel insurance when arriving to Miami for the program.

DRESS CODE

**Please note that the dress code is strictly enforced.*

Ballet Dress Code for Women/Girls

- Tights under any black leotard with any sleeve length, except Saturdays
 - On Saturdays, students may wear any solid color leotard for Ballet
- Soft shoes
- Pointe shoes
- Short matching skirts can be worn for Variations classes only.
- Hair must be pulled back away from the face in a neat bun.
- No jewelry may be worn except for small earrings.
- No sweat pants, legwarmers or sweatshirts are allowed during class.

Ballet Dress Code for Men/Boys

- A white short sleeve leotard or t-shirt (without any writing on it) tucked inside black tight
 - On Saturdays, students may wear any color shirt and any color tights
- Black tights
- White socks
- White ballet shoes
- No jewelry may be worn except for small earrings
- No sweat pants, legwarmers, or sweatpants are allowed during class

Weight Training Dress Code for Men/Boys

- Sneakers
- Any shirt
- Any shorts/pants

Contemporary Dress Code for Men & Women

- Leggings or black shorts
- Bare foot
- Any solid color leotard for girls
- Any color t-shirt for men (no writing on it)
- No sweat pants, legwarmers or sweatshirts are allowed during class.

Stretch/Yoga/Pilates Dress Code for Men & Women

- Theraband
- Yoga Mat Required

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The 2026 MCB Summer Intensive fees and payment schedule are listed below. In order to secure a space in the program, you must pay the non-refundable registration fee, activity fee, and non-refundable tuition and housing deposits (if applicable) upon registration.

Payment Options

- Full Payment - Non-refundable Tuition Payment & Fees due upon registration: \$3,570.00
- Two Payments - 1st PMT - Non-refundable 50% Tuition Deposit and Fees due upon registration: \$1,697.50 + \$150.00 + \$25.00 = **\$1,872.50** / 2nd PMT Non-refundable Tuition balance due by April 1st, 2026: **\$1,697.50**

Tuition/fees and all payments made are non-refundable and non-transferable regardless of circumstance, either before, during, or after the program.

HOUSING

Miami City Ballet School is pleased to offer 2 housing options to support our summer students.

Housing options include building security and a live-in Housing Manager. Live-in Resident Assistants support and meet the needs of students during the programs. Additionally, students will have opportunities to participate in social based activities among fellow housing students as ice-breakers and socials for students to connect outside of classes.

COLLINS POINTE, THE MCBS RESIDENCE HALL (Ages 12 -16)

Includes Lunch and Dinner (Mon – Sat)

In Collins Pointe, MCBS provides secure housing, just a one-minute walk across the plaza from MCBS studios. This housing option is available for summer students ages 12 - 16. Students must turn 12 by move-in day (June 21, 2026) to enroll in housing at Collins Pointe. Each “suite’ is fully furnished and offers a common area for socializing or relaxation. Washers and dryers, internet and a large ice machine are available. Each room houses up to 4 students, providing bunk beds, closets, desks, and 1 bathroom per bedroom. Lunch and dinner are provided for the ultimate in living ease, security, and proximity. The residence offers a community room, kitchen, and quiet room.

TRADEWINDS APARTMENTS (Ages 15+)

Supervised Housing at Tradewinds Apartments is available for Summer Intensive students ages 15+. Students must turn 15 by move-in day (June 21, 2026) to enroll in Tradewinds Apartments. Housing is situated two blocks (about a 5-7 minute walk) from MCB studios and is designed to support independent living. Each one-bedroom apartment suite occupies up to four students and is approximately 750 square feet, featuring a large bedroom with two bunk beds, living room, bathroom, two large closets and an oversized kitchen. These apartment style residences are fully furnished with a fully equipped kitchen and all utilities, linens, and housewares provided.

Important to note: Tradewinds Apartments is set up as independent living. Students are responsible for their own meals complete with grocery shopping and cooking/meal prep(breakfast/lunch/dinner), laundry, and commute to and from the studios.

No Meals are provided.

Non-refundable Housing remainder due by April 1st, 2026: **\$2,625.00**

TRADEWINDS APARTMENTS (15+)

Housing Total: **\$2,825.00** (meals/transportation are NOT included)

Non-refundable 30% Housing Deposit due upon registration:

\$847.50 + \$5.00 Admin Fee = **\$852.50**

Non-refundable Housing remainder due by April 1st, 2026: **\$1,977.50**

To Register for Housing: You must first complete registration for the program. Then, log back into your Portal. The Housing Add-On option is found and available under "My Students". This option is only visible AFTER you submit registration and payment for summer intensive program enrollment. Complete housing details and handbook are included in the Add-On option when registering.
