You have been accepted to Miami City Ballet School's 2026 Young Dancer Intensive!

We are excited to invite you to train in our two-week Young Dancer Intensive program. During this two-week program, students will have the chance to train with MCB's renowned faculty and experience the highest quality of dance education. This is a wonderful opportunity for students to be exposed to MCB School's curriculum and to be immersed in classical dance technique with focus on the speed, clarity and precision that is a hallmark of the exceptional training at MCBS. Students will get to experience first-hand what it is like to train at Miami City Ballet School.

Our young dancers will find themselves immersed in an environment where we foster artistry, creativity, and respect for one another, while demanding dedication, focus, and hard work. Through this dedicated two-week training, these young students will find growth, improvements, and confidence in their dancing.

All initial registration materials must be completed and submitted online via the MCB School Portal. Please use the login credentials found in your acceptance email to log in to your account. In order to secure your spot, the following must be paid: Registration & Activity Fee, a 50% Tuition deposit, and all registration forms submitted to MCBS. The program is on a first- come-first-serve basis.

Registration deadline is 10 business days after the acceptance email was received. Once the program reaches full capacity, you will be placed on a waitlist. Be sure to complete registration as soon as possible to ensure your place in the program.

The Young Dancer Intensive program consists of a carefully designed curriculum to support each technical level and provide the highest caliber of training in a creative and artistic environment. Students will participate in a well-rounded selection of classes. The curriculum consists of Ballet, Pre-Pointe/Pointe, Stretch, Variations, Contemporary, Musical Theater, Pilates, and Ballet Terminology. Classes are held five days per week (Monday through Friday). On the first day of the program, all students will participate in a level placement class and program orientation. Students can expect up to 18 – 20 hours of dance instruction per week (each week may vary with the schedule).

Students must commit to the entirety of the program. At the conclusion of the Young Dancer Intensive, students who demonstrate exceptional talent, potential, and commitment are invited to join MCB School's accomplished year-round training program in our Student Division.

SCHEDULE

Students will follow an assigned group schedule on Placement Day for Monday, July 27, 2026 which will be sent via email one week before the start of the program in your “What to Expect” email. The final Young Dancer Intensive schedule with the assigned class level will be available in the student's MCB School [Portal](#) on Tuesday, July 28, 2026. Classes end on Friday, August 7, 2026.

LEVEL PLACEMENT

Your level placement for the MCBS Young Dancer Intensive will be confirmed after a placement class on Monday, July 27, 2026. Level placement is exclusively decided by Artistic Staff on the first day of the program and is non-negotiable. The students' assigned level for the Young Dancer Intensive will be posted in the MCB School Portal on the second day of the program.

ACTIVITIES

Throughout the programs, we aim to build community and harbor a safe, inclusive, and accepting environment for all of our students. Students will have an opportunity to participate in activities specially curated to engage students and help build new and lasting friendships.

PARENT OBSERVATION CLASS

DRESS CODE

Ballet Dress Code for Girls

- Black leotard (any sleeve length)
- Tights
- Soft ballet shoes
- If age and ability allow, pointe shoes
- Hair must be in a neat bun
- No jewelry or watches may be worn except for small earrings

Ballet Dress Code for Boys

- A white short sleeve leotard or t-shirt (without any writing on it) tucked inside black tights
- Black tights
- White ankle socks
- White ballet shoes

Contemporary/Musical Theater Dress Code for Boys and Girls

- Leggings or black shorts
- Black leotard for girls
- White or black t-shirt for boys (no writing on it)
- Jazz shoes (optional)
- No sweat pants, legwarmers or sweatshirts are allowed during class.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The 2026 MCB Young Dancer Intensive fees and payment schedule are listed below. In order to secure a space in the program, at registration, you must pay the non-refundable registration and activity fee and non-refundable tuition deposit.

Young Dancer Intensive Payments

Tuition Fee: \$1,400.00

Fees Breakdown:*

- Registration Fee: \$75
- Activity Fee: \$10

Non-refundable 50% Tuition Deposit and Fees due upon registration:

- \$700.00 + \$75.00 + \$10.00 = **\$785.00**

Non-refundable Tuition balance due by April 1st, 2025: **\$700**

Tuition/fees and all payments made are non-refundable, and non-transferable regardless of circumstance, either before, during, or after the program.

***NEW* HOUSING**

Miami City Ballet School is pleased to offer housing at Collins Poine, the MCBS Residence Hall, to support our Young Dancer Intensive students.

COLLINS POINTE, the MCBS RESIDENCE HALL (Ages 12+)

Includes Lunch and Dinner (Mon – Sat)

Collins Point provides secure chaperoned housing, just a one-minute walk across the plaza from MCBS studios. This housing option is available for summer students ages 12 and up. Students must turn 12 by move-in day (July 27, 2026) to enroll in housing at Collins Pointe. Each “suite’ is fully furnished and offers a common area for socializing or relaxation. Washers and dryers, internet, and a large ice machine are available. Each room houses up to 4 students, providing bunk beds, closets, desks, and one bathroom per bedroom. Lunch and dinner are provided for the ultimate in living ease, security, and proximity. The residence offers a community room, kitchen, and quiet room.

Supervised housing at Collins Pointe includes building security, a live-in Housing Manager and a Resident Assistant are available to support and meet the needs of students during the programs. Additionally, students will have opportunities to participate in social-based activities among fellow housing students as ice-breakers and socials for students to connect outside of classes.

Space is limited and housing is on a first come first serve basis. Once housing is full, a waitlist be started. *All housing payments made are non-refundable, and non-transferable regardless of circumstance, either before, during, or after the program.*

This option is only visible AFTER you submit registration and payment for summer intensive program enrollment. Complete housing details and handbook are included in the Add-on option when registering.
